



## **DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clute, Texas on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 2024, recognizes the imminent threat posed by **HURRICANE BERYL**; and


**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Clute has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to mitigate the potential impacts of a tropical system including the loss of life and severe property damage, to alleviate the suffering of people, and to protect or rehabilitate property, roads, parks and other infrastructure within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clute Emergency Management Plan should be activated.

### **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CLUTE, TEXAS:**

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Clute, Brazoria County, Texas, pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Clute, Texas.
3. Pursuant to §48.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Clerk, and copy sent to Brazoria County Office of Emergency Management and the Texas Department of Emergency Management.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of all aid and assistance as deemed necessary or desirable by those administering such plans and activates the preparedness and response aspects of the City of Clute emergency management plan, and any other such plans.
5. This proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
