

Construction Bid Advertisement

The City of Clute will receive sealed bids for the **CDBG HAZ-MIT Clute Regional Flood Risk Reduction Project (CL123419)** addressed to the City of Clute office at 108 E Main Street, Clute, TX 77531 until 3:00 p.m. on Monday, May 18th, 2026. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 3:00 p.m. on Monday, May 18th, 2026 at 108 E Main Street, Clute, TX 77531.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work including, but not limited to: Installation and modification of approximately 2,100 linear feet (LF) of culvert; remove and replace of approximately 2,835 square yards (SY) of existing asphalt/concrete driveway pavement and base, installation of concrete roadside ditch channel lining, and roadside ditch excavation, erosion control, and site restoration.

Bidders accept sole responsibility for downloading all of the required documents, plans, specifications, bid forms, and addenda required for bidding.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference for the project will be held on May 8th, 2026 at 11:00 am at the City of Clute office at 108 E Main Street, Clute, TX 77531.

Questions are to be submitted using the question-and-answer process on the procurement website (<http://www.civcastusa.com>). Responses to questions posted on the procurement website will be posted for the benefit of all Bidders. A response will be posted for questions submitted until 3:00 p.m. on May 13th, 2026.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to City of Clute or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

City of Clute reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by City of Clute for a period not to exceed 45 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.
