

RESOLUTION NO. 08-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLUTE RATIFYING, AFFIRMING AND EXTENDING THE CITY OF CLUTE'S DECLARATION OF DISASTER AND PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREVIOUSLY ISSUED BY THE MAYOR BEYOND THE INITIAL SEVEN DAY PERIOD THROUGH APRIL 9, 2020

WHEREAS, the City of Clute, Texas under Proclamation of the Mayor issued a Declaration of Disaster and Public Health Emergency in recognition of the imminent threat posed by CoVid 19 on the 17th day of March 2020; and


WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus and declared as a global pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO); and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code Section 418.108 requires the local Governing Body to renew or continue the Declaration; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to take additional steps to prepare for, respond to, and mitigate the spread of COVID-19 to protect the health and welfare of Clute residents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLUTE, TEXAS that the Declaration of Disaster and Public Health Emergency Proclaimed by the Mayor on March 17, 2020 including all provisions included therein and hereto attached, is hereby Ratified, Affirmed and Extended through April 9, 2020.
