## Resolution

### APPOINTING MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

**WHEREAS,** Clute, Brazoria County Texas, provides for the creation of a Planning and Zoning Commission which shall consist of not less than seven (7) nor more than nine (9) citizens of Clute, each of whom shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years each and provided that vacancies of an unexpired term shall be filled by the City Council for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the provision of Section 1 of the Zoning Enabling Act of the State of Texas, codified as Article 1011a, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas (1925), the City Council of said City adopted Ordinance No. 75-41 on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of November, 1975 providing that the Planning and Zoning Commission of said City appointed pursuant to the provision of said Section 14.03 of the Home Rule Charter shall be the Zoning Commission of said City, said Ordinance 75-41 now being codified as Section 2-101 of the Code of Ordinance, City of Clute, Texas; and

**WHEREAS,** Positions 2 and 7 are vacant and the City Council of said City now desires to fill the positions.



**First,** That David Culpepper is hereby appointed to fill Position 2, which expires in July 2025; and

**Second,** That Michael Doucet is hereby reappointed to fill Position 7, which expires in July 2024; and

**Third,** That this Resolution, after execution and attestation, shall be maintained in the permanent records of the City of Clute, Texas
